

WT-5847 Tactile floor marking tape - Guidance system for the blind

The tactile floor marking tape enables blind and visually impaired people to find their way. The tape can be stuck to almost all solid surfaces. It is extremely wear-resistant, highly adhesive and has a non-slip surface with good grip even when wet.

MORE INFORMATION

It is possible to drive over the belt with floor conveyors. Turning and twisting on the tape with floor conveyors or similar heavy vehicles must be avoided and can lead to the destruction of the tape. To achieve optimum adhesion, the substrate must be free of release agents such as grease, oil, surfactants, dirt and dust. Store in a dry and UV-protected place at 20°C to 30°C.
